

# Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport

## August 2013 Traffic Recap

Total traffic for August 2013 was 1,919,625, down .2% over last year. Domestic traffic was down .6% and international traffic was up 1.4%.

August commercial operations totaled 17,297, down 5.5% over last year. General Aviation totaled 2,540, up 4.7%. Total aircraft movements for the period were 19,837, down 4.3%.

Leading the way in positive growth for US carriers for the month were:

- Frontier +67.7% (service to Trenton did not operate in August last year)
- AirTran +32.7%
- JetBlue +11.7%
- US Airways +10.2%.

Canadian service was up significantly on the international side:

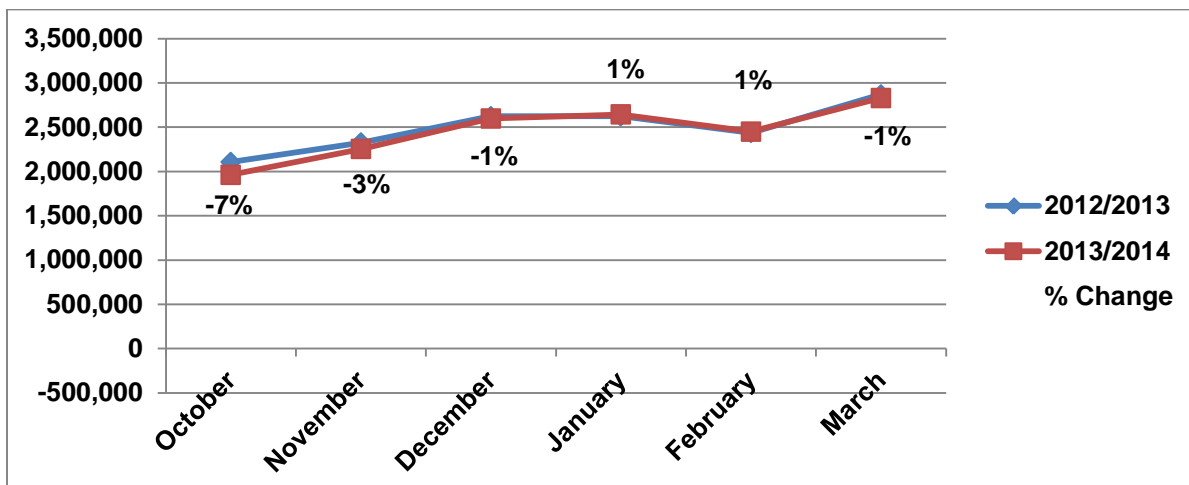
- Air Canada +16.1%
- Canjet +15.3%
- Westjet +11.8%

Airlines with negative totals include:

- Southwest continues to restructure/consolidate and was down 25%
- Virgin - 17.8%
- Delta - 8.4%
- American - 1%
- Spirit was - .6%

As mentioned in previous recaps, traffic will begin to improve towards the end of the calendar year. Year to date load factors are comparable to last year (average of 84.6% for both years) so traffic should be up/down accordingly.

The chart below illustrates total available schedule seats. Cruise season traffic and airport activity should be down considerably for October. There will be a slight improvement in November and December and continuing through the remainder of the season.



Below is the year to date traffic, percent change in growth over last year, and market share of our top carriers.
