Traffic for August Continued to Grow

Total traffic for August was 2,799,165, up 19.9 percent. Domestic traffic increased 20.3 percent. International traffic was up 18.8 percent.

August was the 41st consecutive month of growth in total traffic. It was also the 13th consecutive month of double digit growth in international passenger traffic.

There were 347 daily departures in August 2017 compared to 297 last year. This is an increase of 50 daily departures to 13 destinations that were not served in August 2016.

- Fastest growing large hub airport for the 12 months ending July.
- Ranked 10th in international traffic for YTD January-July.

New Service

- Norwegian to Barcelona on August 22.
- Norwegian to Martinique in October.
- JetBlue to Salt Lake City in November.
- JetBlue to Atlanta in March 2018 with two daily departures.
- Delta to Salt Lake City in November.
- Allegiant to Milwaukee and Norfolk in November.
- Southwest to Punta Cana, San Jose, and Provinciales in November.
- Southwest to Aruba in March 2018.

Passenger Traffic Expected to Reach 33 Million in 2017

The chart below is the scheduled available seats for the rest of the year. The average for the period is 13 percent. Based on a conservative average growth rate of 10 percent, we estimate that FLL should reach 32.8 million passengers for calendar year 2017. It is likely that we will reach very close to 33 million.
