

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update January 2015

Total passenger traffic for January 2015 was 2,372,362, up 10.4 percent over January last year. Domestic traffic was up 7.1 percent and international traffic was up 24.5 percent.

January marked the 14th consecutive month of double-digit growth in international passenger traffic. Ten out of the last 14 months showed international growth exceeding 20 percent.

Air Carrier Operations were 21,502, up 10.6 percent over January last year. General Aviation was 3,511, up .3 percent over last year. Total aircraft operations were 25,013, up 9.1 percent over January 2014.

The table below shows January's change in passenger activity and market share for FLL's major carriers.

Total passenger traffic will continue to grow over the next few months. New service includes:

- Spirit to Cleveland in February
- JetBlue to Cleveland and Detroit in April, and Baltimore in November
- Southwest will begin new service to Washington National in August
- Allegiant will begin new service to Syracuse in February, Columbus (Ohio) in March, and Indianapolis in April

The chart below illustrates the percent growth in total scheduled seats for the next six months. Passenger traffic should respond accordingly.
