

## Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update July 2015

Total passenger traffic for July 2015 was 2,315,600. This is up 10.3 percent over July last year. Domestic traffic increased by 8.2 percent. International traffic was up 18.6 percent.

July 2015 was the 20<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of double-digit growth in international passengers. It was also the 16<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of growth in total passengers.

Air Carrier operations were up 8.9 percent over July last year. General Aviation was 2,849, up 6.7 percent. Total aircraft operations were 22,864, up 8.6 percent over July 2014.

The table below shows July's change in passenger activity and market share for FLL's top 10 air carriers. All top 10 carriers showed monthly growth.

Future new international flights include:

- JetBlue
  - Mexico City in October 2015.
  - Providenciales (Turks and Caicos) in November 2015.
  - Quito, Ecuador in the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2016.

New domestic flights include:

- JetBlue to Baltimore, Charleston, Philadelphia, and Albany in December 2015.
- Southwest
  - Washington D.C., Reagan National Airport in August 2015.
  - Minneapolis in January 2016.
- Allegiant
  - Portsmouth, NH; Akron, OH; and Rochester in October 2015.
  - San Antonio in November 2015.
  - Grand Rapids, MI (seasonal) in December 2015.
- United returns to Cleveland in October 2015.

Traffic will increase for the rest of 2015 and through the first quarter of 2016. Calendar year 2015 should exceed 26 million passengers.

The chart below shows the month-over-month increase in schedule seats. Passenger traffic should respond accordingly.
