

# Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update July 2016

## Passenger Traffic

Total passenger traffic for July 2016 was 2,490,684, up 7.6 percent over July of last year. Domestic traffic increased by 9 percent. International traffic was up 2.5 percent. Calendar year-to-date total traffic was up 8.4 percent. Fiscal year-to-date total traffic was up 8.5 percent.

July was the 28<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of growth in total passenger traffic. The most recent Airports Council International data (June 2016) ranked FLL 1<sup>st</sup> in domestic passenger growth among large hub airports.

In 2015, FLL ranked 21<sup>st</sup> in total passenger traffic. For the period of January-June 2016, FLL jumped both Philadelphia and La Guardia and is now ranked 19<sup>th</sup> in total passenger traffic. It is anticipated that FLL will remain in that position for calendar year 2016.

The estimated total load factor for June 2016 was 88 percent. It is about the same as June last year.

## Operations

Commercial air carrier operations were 20,671. This is up 3.3 percent over July 2015.

## Traffic Outlook

Traffic will continue to grow for the remainder of the year and into next year. The month-over-month increase in available seats for the remainder of the year is shown below. Traffic should respond accordingly. We anticipate passenger traffic will exceed 29 million in 2016, closer to 30 million.
