

## Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport June 2012 Traffic Recap

Total traffic for June 2012 was 1,907,074, up 1.9% over June last year. Domestic traffic was 1,627,524, up 1.9%. International traffic was 279,550, up 1.7% over last year.

It was the busiest June on record surpassing 2008 by almost 10,000 passengers.

Spirit was once again FLL's largest carrier and carried 20,000 more passengers than JetBlue for the month.

June commercial operations totaled 18,066, up .2% over last year. General Aviation totaled 2,823 and showed 0% growth over last year. Total aircraft movements for the period were 20,889, up .1% over last year.

Airlines with positive growth for the month were:

- JetBlue +21.7%
- AirTran +19.6%
- Delta +8.3%.

Airlines on the negative side included:

- American - 11.8%
- Spirit - 9.7%
- Southwest - 2.6%
- Continental - .4%.

Traffic for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters of CY 2012 should begin to show slight improvement. In addition to the arrival of Alaska Airlines from Seattle on July 17<sup>th</sup>, new service in the next few months includes:

- Spirit to Baltimore and Minneapolis
- JetBlue to Providence
- United to Washington Dulles

These additions will help offset decreases by other carriers.
