

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update May 2017

May Traffic Climbed

Total traffic for May 2017 was 2,629,156, up 9.9 percent over May 2016. Domestic traffic was up 8.2 percent. International traffic was up 16.9 percent.

May was the 38th consecutive month of growth in total traffic. It was also the 10th consecutive month of double digit growth in international passenger traffic.

January to May 2017 traffic was up 11 percent.
