October Traffic

- Total traffic: 2,573,461, up 7.4%
- Domestic traffic: 2,010,988, up 6.4%
- International traffic: 562,473, up 11.3%
- Year-to-date (YTD) total passengers: 29,684,765, up 11.0%
- Total traffic has increased 54 out of the last 55 months
- There were 18 more scheduled daily domestic departures and 14 more scheduled daily international departures vs. October 2017.

- December: Spirit to Cali, Colombia and JetBlue to Steamboat Springs

On the Books so far for 2019

- February JetBlue to Phoenix, St. Maarten and Guayaquil
Spirit to Jacksonville and Austin
Silver to Pensacola and The Bight (Bahamas)
- In order to reach 36M total passengers for 2018, November and December passenger traffic will have to increase by an average of 9% for each month. Currently November seats are up 10.1% and December seats are up 7.2%, so it will be close.
