Total Passenger Traffic Continues to Grow

- Total traffic: 3,100,652, up 5.3%
- Domestic traffic: 2,382,902, up 2.7%
- International traffic: 717,750, up 14.8%
- Total traffic has increased 48 out of the last 49 months

Year to date (Jan-Apr) total passenger traffic was 12,484,430, up 8.5%.

Commercial aircraft operations for April were 25,751, up 5.6% over last year. This is an increase of 46 take offs and landings a day.

Cargo Increasing

- Air freight is up 40% over the last 5 years (year to date)
- International air freight is now 24% of total air freight

Additional Cuba Service

- JetBlue has 2 daily flights to Havana and will add a 3rd in November
- Southwest has 2 daily flights to Havana and will add a 3rd in August

More Growth on the Horizon for 2018

From May to September (end of Fiscal Year 2018), total scheduled seats are up 10%. Based on scheduled seats and historical data, total passenger traffic should reach 35M for Fiscal Year 2018.

Total passenger traffic should approach 36M for Calendar Year 2018.
