August Traffic Growing

- Total traffic: 3,021,479, up 7.9%
- Domestic traffic: 2,223,700, up 4.7%
- International traffic: 797,779, up 18.1%
- Year-to-date (YTD) total passengers: 24,695,933, up 9.5%
- Total traffic has increased 52 out of the last 53 months
- There were 4 more scheduled domestic departures and 15 more scheduled international departures vs. August 2017.

Airports Council International for July 2018

- FLL ranked 2nd in total passenger growth, 12 months ending August, up 9.9%
- 2nd in YTD total passenger growth, up 10.0%
- 10th in YTD international passenger traffic
- 18th in YTD total traffic passenger traffic

New Service

- September: Spirit to Asheville and Greensboro
- October: JetBlue to Grand Cayman; Allegiant to Flint; Norwegian to Rome
- December: Spirit to Cali, Colombia; JetBlue to Steam Boat Springs

New Airlines

- Swoop: Twice weekly to Hamilton, Ontario starting in October
- Frontier: Four weekly departures to Trenton and Islip starting in November

More Growth on the Horizon for 2018

- The percentage increase in scheduled available seats for the remaining months of 2018 is depicted below. Passenger traffic should grow at approximately the same rate.
