

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport December 2017 – Year End Recap

2017 Finishes Strong

December Traffic

- Total traffic: 3.0M, up 8.4%.
- Domestic traffic: 2.3M, up 5.7%.
- International traffic: 730,463, up 17.9%.

Total traffic has increased 46 out of the last 47 months.

2017 Year End Traffic Recap

- Total traffic: 32.5M, up 11.3%.
- Domestic traffic: 25.3M, up 9.4%.
- International traffic: 7.2M, up 18.6%.
- 2017 was the 4th consecutive year of double digit growth in international traffic.
- 353 scheduled daily departures, up 10.1% over 2016.
- Scheduled available one-way seats up 13.3%.
- FLL will jump Philadelphia and La Guardia and will be the 19th busiest U.S. airport (up from 21st).

2017 was a Banner Year for New Service

The year saw the arrival of British Airways with service to London-Gatwick and 27 other new routes by existing carriers. (below)

- FLL was the fastest growing large hub airport for year to date and 12 months ending November.
- FLL ranked 12th for international traffic during both those periods.
- FLL ranked 10th for international traffic for the month of November.

New Service in 2018

- Spirit - Columbus in February; Richmond and Guayaquil, Ecuador in March; Cap Haitien, Haiti in April; and seasonal service to Seattle also in April.
- Southwest - Aruba in March, San Antonio in July.
- Azul - Recife, Brazil in May.
- JetBlue – Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands and Santiago, DR in June; Atlanta in March.

More Growth for 2018

- FLL ranks 2nd among large hub airports for growth in scheduled available seats from Jan-Jun 2018, up 8.5%
