December Traffic

- Total traffic: 3,296,230, up 8.4%
- Domestic traffic: 2,460,889, up 6.5%
- International traffic: 835,341, up 19.8%

CY 2018 Passenger Traffic

- Total traffic: 35,963,370, up 10.6%
- Domestic traffic: 27,355,007, up 8.0%
- International traffic: 8,608,363, up 19.8%
- Double digit international growth for the last 5 years
- Positive growth in total traffic every year since 2010
- 13 more scheduled daily domestic departures vs 2017
- 12 more scheduled daily international departures vs 2017

ACI Rankings for October Year-to-Date

- FLL was the fastest growing large hub, traffic up 11.3%
- FLL ranked 18th in total traffic
- FLL ranked 10th in total international traffic
