New Service on the Books for 2019

- October - Spirit to Nashville
- November - Swoop to Winnipeg
- November - Frontier to Cleveland and Cincinnati
- November - Southwest to Cleveland, Louisville, Boston, and Birmingham (all seasonal)
- December - Air Transat to Vancouver

- B737MAX off airline schedules until early November. However, industry observers say that it is unlikely that the aircraft will return to service this year.

- Total traffic: 35,963,370, up 10.6%
- Domestic traffic: 27,355,007, up 8.0%
- International traffic: 8,608,363, up 19.8%

Outlook for the Remainder of 2019

Scheduled available seats for the remainder of the year average a growth rate of 2%. This coupled with Jan-Jun growth of 4% equals a year end growth of approximately 3%. Total passenger traffic for 2019 is estimated to be approximately 37M.
