Traffic Still Climbing

- Total traffic: 3,011,356, up 14.5%.
- Domestic traffic: 2,324,456, 10.8%.
- International traffic: 686,900, up 29.2%.
- Total traffic has increased 49 out of the last 50 months.
- International traffic is now 23% of total traffic compared to 20% for 2017.
- YTD Total passenger 15,495,786, up 9.6%.
- Moving 12 months total traffic 33.8M, up 10.7%.
- May had 24,741 commercial operations, up 12.2% or 87 more flights daily compared to last year.

Airports Council International April Report

- FLL ranked 2nd in international passenger growth Jan-April 2018.
- FLL ranked 3rd in total passenger traffic growth Jan-April 2018.
- FLL ranked 9th in total international passenger traffic Jan-April 2018.

Cargo Increasing

- Jan-May 2018 total cargo was up 13.8% over last year.
- International cargo is now 20% of total cargo.
- Top 5 international imports were: (CBP data for FY 2016-2017, top 5 imports represent 74% of total international imports)
 - Machinery, Mechanical Appliances and Parts.
 - Electronics, Sound Recorders, TV and Parts.
 - Textiles and Wearing Apparel.
 - Products of Iron and Steel.
 - Aircraft Parts and Accessories.

New Service

May: Azul to Recife, Spirit to St. Croix.
 June: JetBlue to Santiago (DR).
 July: Southwest to San Antonio.
 September: Spirit to Ashville and Greenville Spartanburg.
 October: JetBlue to Grand Cayman, Allegiant to Flint, Norwegian to Rome and Madrid.

More Growth on the Horizon for 2018

FLL is expected to reach 18.5M for the first 6 months of 2018, up 10% over last year.
