### November Traffic Still Going Strong

- Total traffic: 2,736,896, up 9.7%
- Domestic traffic: 2,129,672, up 7.1%
- International traffic: 607,224, up 20.0%

Total traffic has increased 43 out of the last 44 months.

According to Airports Council International, FLL was the fastest growing large hub airport in all categories. For the 12 months ending October, Philadelphia remained at the bottom of the list behind La Guardia and Houston Intercontinental Airport.

## New Service

- JetBlue started Salt Lake City on November 16th, Atlanta starting in March 2018.
- Delta started Salt Lake City on November 17th.
- Allegiant to Milwaukee and Norfolk on November 17th.
- Southwest to Punta Cana, San Jose, and Providenciales on November 5th, Aruba in March 2018, San Antonio in July 2018.
- Azul to Belem, Brazil on December 10<sup>th</sup> and Recife, Brazil in March 2018.
- Spirit to Columbus in February 2018 and Richmond in March 2018. Seasonal service to SEA starting in April 2018.

## Passenger Traffic Expected to Exceed 32 Million in 2017

Based on scheduled available seats and assuming load factors remain constant, Dec traffic should be up 6% and 2017 should end at approximately 32.5M, up 11%
