

# Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport November 2018

## November Traffic

- Total traffic: 2,982,375, up 8.9%
- Domestic traffic: 2,289,393, up 7.5%
- International traffic: 692,982, up 14.1%
- Year-to-date (YTD) total passengers: 32,667,140, up 10.9%
- Moving 12 months: 35,708,340, up 10.6%
- Total traffic has increased 55 out of the last 56 months
- There were 28 more scheduled daily departures vs. November 2017

## Airports Council International Rankings for September 2018

- FLL was the fastest growing large hub airport, traffic up 11.6%
- FLL ranked 18<sup>th</sup> in total passenger traffic
- FLL ranked 10<sup>th</sup> in total international passenger traffic
