## September Traffic

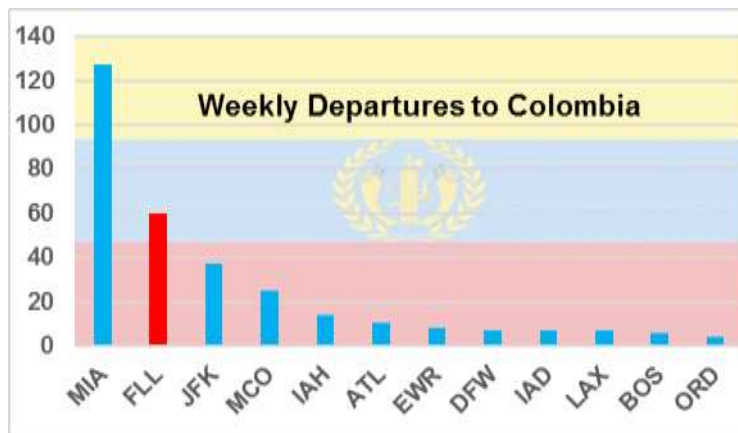
- Total traffic: 2,419,516, up 35.7%
- Domestic traffic: 1,835,930, up 32.1%
- International traffic: 583,586, up 48.8%
- Year-to-date (YTD) total passengers: 27,115,449, up 11.4%
- Total traffic has increased 53 out of the last 54 months
- There were 13 more scheduled domestic departures and 15 more scheduled international departures vs. September 2017.

## New Service

- September: Spirit to Asheville and Greensboro
- October: JetBlue to Grand Cayman, Allegiant to Flint
- November: Swoop to Hamilton, Ontario, Frontier to Trenton and Islip
- December: Spirit to Cali, Colombia, JetBlue to Steamboat Springs
- With the addition of Cali, FLL will have 60 weekly departures to Colombia. More than any other U.S. airport except MIA. Below is a chart that depicts this data.



## Busy Cruise Season Ahead

- Based on scheduled seats for the remainder of the year and into 2019, total passenger traffic should be up approximately 9% for Q4 and 4% for Q1 of 2018.
- Total passenger traffic is still on track to reach 36 million for 2018.
