

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update November 2015

Total passenger traffic for November 2015 was 2,242,656, up 10.3 percent over November last year. Domestic traffic increased by 9.5 percent. International traffic was up 10.3 percent.

November was the 24th consecutive month of double-digit growth in international passenger traffic. It was also the 20th consecutive month of growth in total passengers.

Air Carrier operations were 19,756, up 5.3 percent over last year. General Aviation was 3,475, up 10.2 percent. Total aircraft operations were 23,231, up 6 percent over November 2014.

Airports Council International data for the 12 months ending October 2015 lists FLL as the 3rd fastest growing airport with total traffic up 9.3 percent. This is behind Seattle and Washington Reagan, respectively.

- Allegiant began service to:
 - San Antonio in November 2015.
 - Returned to Grand Rapids, MI (seasonal) in December 2015.
- Spirit will begin new service to Philadelphia in April 2016.

Total passenger traffic for calendar year 2015 will exceed 26 million. It will continue to grow in 2016. The chart below depicts the percentage increase of available scheduled seats for the first half of the year. Traffic should respond accordingly.
