

## Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport Traffic Update October 2015

Total passenger traffic for October 2015 was 1,975,187, up 8.5 percent over October last year. Domestic traffic increased by 7.6 percent and international traffic was up 12.6 percent.

October was the 23<sup>rd</sup> consecutive month of double-digit growth in international passenger traffic. It was also the 19<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of growth in total passengers.

Air Carrier operations were 17,495, up 6.6 percent over last year. General Aviation was 2,685, down 8 percent. Total aircraft operations were 20,180, up 4.4 percent over October 2014.

Airports Council International (ACI) data for the 12 months ending September 2015 lists FLL as the 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest growing airport with total traffic up 9.5 percent. This is behind Seattle and Washington DC, respectively.

Recent/upcoming new international service includes:

- JetBlue started or will start service to
  - Providenciales (Turks and Caicos) in November 2015.
  - Quito, Ecuador in February 2016.
  - Barbados in April 2016.
- Dynamic Airways will begin service to Maracaibo, Venezuela in December 2015.

Recent/new domestic service includes:

- JetBlue began service or will start flights to:
  - Baltimore, Charleston, and Philadelphia in November 2015.
  - Albany in December 2015.
  - Seasonal service to Syracuse in January 2016.
- Southwest - Minneapolis in January 2016.
- Allegiant – began service or will start flights to:
  - Portsmouth, NH; Akron, OH; and Rochester, NY in October 2015.
  - San Antonio in November 2015.
  - Grand Rapids, MI (seasonal) in December 2015.

Outlook in the near term remains very positive. The chart below depicts the growth in total scheduled seats. Passenger growth should correspond accordingly.
