

Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport September Traffic Recap

Total traffic for September 2012 was 1,518,293, up 3.7% over September last year. Domestic traffic was 1,308,088, up 4%. International traffic was 210,205, up 2.3%.

September was the 4th consecutive month of positive growth in total passengers and busiest September on record.

September commercial operations totaled 15,868, up 3.5% over last year. General Aviation totaled 2,132, down 13.8% over last year. Total aircraft movements for the period were 18,000, up 1.1%.

FY 2012 (October 1, 2011 thru September 30, 2012) ended with total traffic up .5%. The outlook for the remainder of 2012 remains positive.

However, hundreds of flights were canceled in October due to Hurricane Sandy. This will probably impact total traffic to some degree.

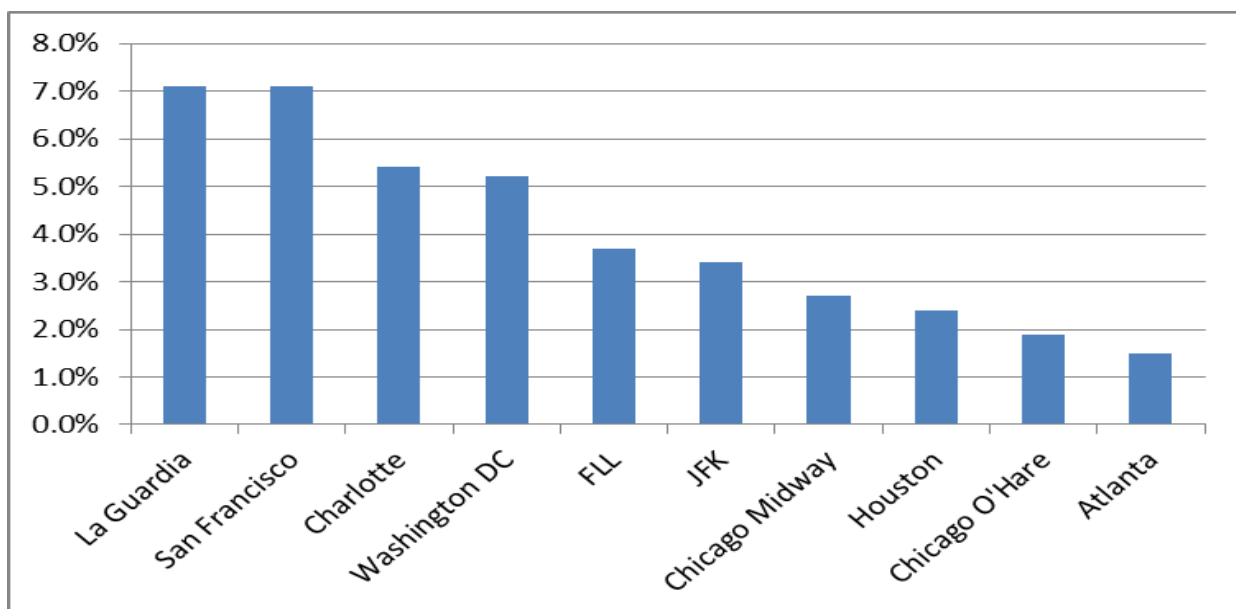
Airlines with positive growth for the month were:

- AirTran up 35.1%
- JetBlue up 15.1%
- Spirit up 3.9%
- US Airways up 1.8%
- United up 1.3%.

Carriers on the negative side were:

- Southwest down 6.9%
- Delta down 4.2%
- Virgin America down 15.6%. (Virgin operated a large number of smaller A319 equipment with less seating capacity)

For the month of September, FLL ranked 5th in total traffic growth among the large hub airports that reported to Airports Council International (ACI). The chart below depicts the top 10 airports.



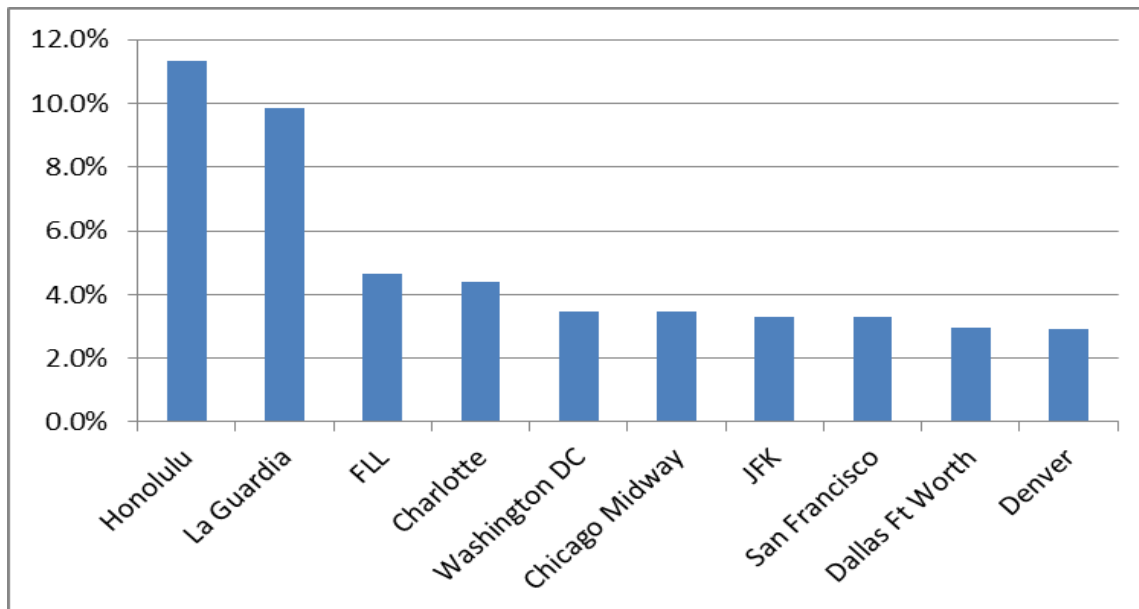
New service in the next few months includes the arrival of Tiara Air Aruba on November 16th with five weekly departures to Aruba with continuing service to Venezuela. Additional new service and increases in capacity for November include:

- Spirit to Baltimore and Minneapolis
- JetBlue to Providence
- Allegiant to Asheville
- United to Washington Dulles

The chart below shows the increase in available seats for the next few months. You can see the growth is very significant.
