Chronological History Timeline:

Date: July 16, 2021

I adopted Rose from ACAD on July 16, 2021. At the time of her adoption, she was extremely fearful, but with consistent care, patience, and love, she became a deeply bonded companion and an important part of my daily life.

Date: April 16, 2025

Rose did not greet me at the door as she normally does. Instead, she remained lying quietly in her cage. I greeted her and, believing she might simply be tired, did not initially recognize that she was injured.

Date: April 17, 2025

The same behavior continued. When I returned home, Rose was again lying in her cage. When I encouraged her to come out, she showed visible hesitation and difficulty moving. Upon observing her more closely, it was clear that she was struggling to walk. After speaking with my family, I was informed that one of the neighbor's children had accidentally dropped Rose and stepped on her on a concrete surface while attempting to pick her up. I contacted the Pet Surgery Center immediately, seeking urgent medical care. Unfortunately, I was unable to arrive before the facility closed, so I scheduled the earliest available appointment for evaluation.

Date: April 18, 2025

Rose was examined at the Pet Surgery Center. I was informed that her femoral bone was dislocated and could not be manually repositioned. As a result, surgical intervention was medically necessary to treat her injury and alleviate her pain. This injury was unexpected and traumatic for both Rose and myself, and the required surgery and associated care resulted in significant and unforeseen veterinary expenses. My sole priority throughout this process has been ensuring Rose's health, comfort, and recovery.

FEMORAL HEAD OSTECTOMY - RIGHT

Patient placed in lateral recumbency and surgical site clipped and aseptically prepped. 1 inch skin incision made with #15 blade cranio-lateral to femoral head. Gluteal muscles separated and partial tenotomy incision of deep gluteal performed to reveal the hip joint. Small Gelpi retractor used to improve visualization. Joint capsule secured with stay sutures and incised. A small Hatt spoon was used to hold the femoral head and Teres ligament was incised. The stifle was abducted 90 degrees so that patella pointed towards the ceiling. A small oscillating saw was used to cut the femoral head in line from base of Greater Trochanter to Lesser Trochanter. The cut edges were confirmed to be smooth and the joint capsule closed with 2/0 PDO. Locking loop suture pattern with 2/0 PDO used to oppose deep gluteal tendon and s.i. pattern with 2/0 PDO used to oppose muscle layers and s.c. pattern to close subcutis. Skin closed with 3/0 Nylon cruciate sutures.

Patient extubated in recovery area and recovered uneventfully with thermal support.

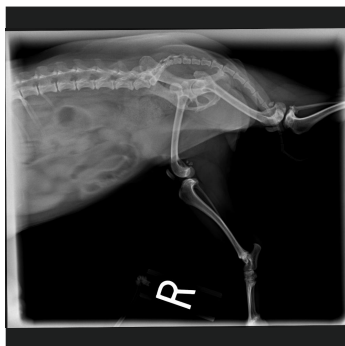
