This notice provides project information brought to you by the Penny for Transportation Mobility Advancement Program, known as MAP Broward. The Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division will hold a **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** for proposed improvements along NE 62nd Street from west of NE 18th Avenue to N Federal Highway in Broward County, Florida.

The purpose of this project is to enhance the infrastructure, mobility, and safety for all road users along NE 62nd Street within the City of Fort Lauderdale. Improvements include milling and resurfacing NE 62nd Street between west of NE 18th Avenue and N Federal Highway, upgrading the existing traffic signal system at the intersection of NE 62nd Street and NE 18th Avenue, extending the eastbound right turn lane and adding a westbound through/right turn lane at the intersection approach of NE 18th Avenue. Additional improvements involve adding missing sidewalk connections for pedestrians and providing dedicated accommodation for bicycles along NE 62nd Street between NE 18th Avenue and N Federal Highway.



This **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** is being held to present the proposed improvements and provide opportunities for public input. County representatives will be available to answer questions during the meeting. The public is encouraged to attend this meeting to review the proposed improvements.
