This notice features project information brought to you by the Penny for Transportation Mobility Advancement Program, known as MAP Broward. The Broward County Highway Construction and Engineering Division will conduct a **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** for the proposed Sheridan Street Improvements from SW 148 Avenue to East of Flamingo Road, Broward County, Florida.

The primary purpose of this project is to improve roadway capacity and enhance pedestrian/bicycle facilities. The construction activities will include widening Sheridan Street from 4-lanes to 6-lanes, new wider sidewalk at east bound and west bound directions with pedestrian ramps, new lighting, landscaping, and irrigation system, signalization, signage and pavement markings.

This **PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING** is being held to present the proposed improvements and provide opportunities for public input. County representatives will be available to answer questions during the meeting. The public is encouraged to attend this meeting to review the proposed transportation improvements.
