Broward County Rail (BCR) North is a proposed commuter rail service developed by Broward County Transit (BCT) to deliver seamless and sustainable transportation between Fort Lauderdale and Deerfield Beach.

BCR North will enhance quality of life by expanding transportation options and providing greater access to employment, education, and essential services. This transformative project spans 15.5 miles along the Florida East Coast (FEC) Railway, seamlessly connecting communities with planned stations at Downtown Fort Lauderdale, Oakland Park, Pompano Beach and Deerfield Beach.


