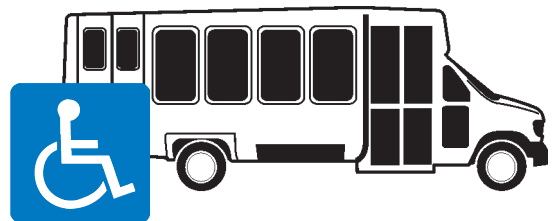

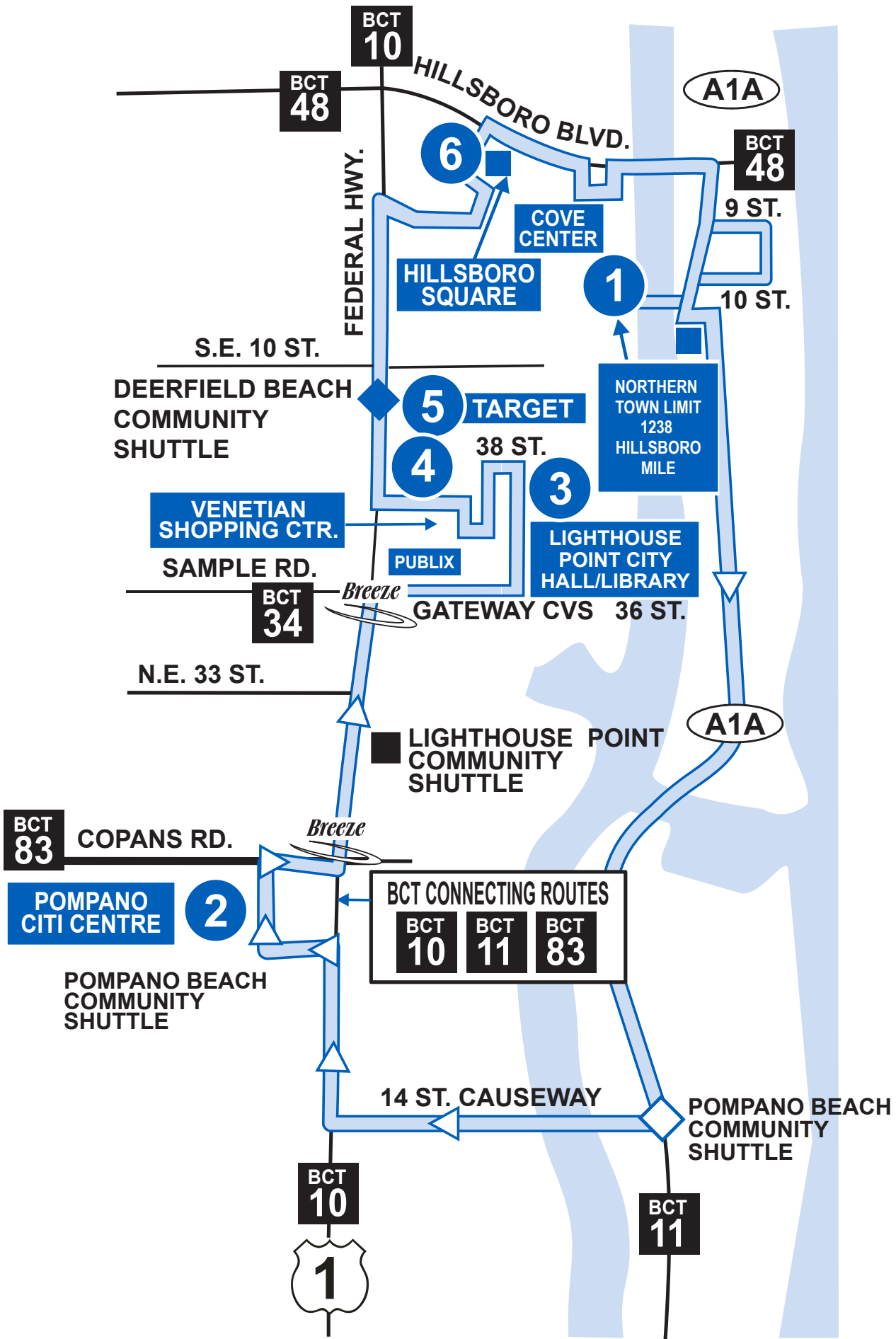
The Community Shuttle will not operate when a hurricane warning has been issued.

## TOWN OF HILLSBORO BEACH COMMUNITY SHUTTLE (BCT ROUTE 721)

The Town of Hillsboro Beach and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Hillsboro Beach Community Shuttle Route. This Community Shuttle service will increase the number of destinations and connections that can be reached through public transit.

**Destinations along Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route included:** Hillsboro Mile, Pompano Citi Centre, Lighthouse Point City Hall/Library, Venetian Shopping Center, Target @ Deerfield Beach and Deerfield Beach Hillsboro Square Plaza (Publix).

Connections are available from the Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route to the following BCT Routes 10, 11, 34, 48, 83, 88, and adjacent Community Shuttle Routes: Pompano Beach Community Shuttle Green and Orange Routes at Pompano Citi Centre; Orange Route at Walmart Supercenter N. Federal Highway and Deerfield Beach Express II Community Shuttle @ Hillsboro Beach Square Plaza and Super Target @ N. Federal Highway.

All shuttles on this route are air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instructions on how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

The Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route is free of charge, but riders making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

### Holiday Schedule

The Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route does not operate on weekends or the following holidays observed by The Town of Hillsboro Beach:

- New Year's Day
- Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
- President's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Veterans Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Day After Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

If holidays fall on a Monday or Wednesday, Service will operate on the Next Day. If Friday is a Holiday, Service operates the Day Before.

## HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday, Wednesday & Friday: 9:00 am – 5:50 pm  
The Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route operates approximately every 60 minutes. Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The shuttle will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions and/or inclement weather may cause the shuttle to arrive earlier or later than the expected time. Please allow yourself enough time when using this service.

The Hillsboro Beach Shuttle Route will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the shuttle.

## BIKE RACKS

Bike racks are available on The Hillsboro Beach Community Shuttle. Bike racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the shuttle approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

### Loading

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- To Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the shuttle.
- To Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

### Unloading

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- **Move quickly to the curb.**
