

1 (b) For Broward County Commission appointments, the automatic removal of
2 a member is deemed effective when written notice of the reason for the removal has
3 been sent to the member by the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs and Professional
4 Standards. For appointments made by other appointing authorities, the automatic
5 removal of a member is deemed effective when written notice of the reason for the
6 removal has been sent to the member by the Council Coordinator.

7 (c) The absence of a member shall be deemed excused under the following
8 circumstances:

9 (1) When the member is performing an authorized alternative activity relating
10 to outside Council business that directly conflicts with the properly-noticed
11 meeting;

12 (2) The death of an immediate family member, ~~who is~~ defined as a spouse,
13 father, mother, stepparent, one who has stood in the place of a parent (in
14 loco parentis), child, ~~and~~ or stepchild domiciled in the member's
15 household;

16 (3) The death of a member's domestic partner; ~~or~~

17 (4) The member's hospitalization;

18 (5) When the member is summoned to jury duty; or

19 (6) When the member is issued a subpoena by a court of competent
20 jurisdiction.

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1 Section 2. SEVERABILITY.

2 If any portion of this Ordinance is determined by any Court to be invalid, the
3 invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the
4 remainder of this Ordinance. If any Court determines that this Ordinance, or any portion
5 hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies),
6 or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any
7 other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

8 Section 3. INCLUSION IN CODE.

9 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of
10 this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Broward County Code; and that
11 the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word
12 "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or such other appropriate word or
13 phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

14 Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
