

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2020-588

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,
4 ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE STREET
5 LIGHTING SUB-DISTRICT IN THE UNINCORPORATED
6 AREA OF BROWARD COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR
2020-2021; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 200.065(2),
8 Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
9 ("Board"), on September 22, 2020, held a public hearing on the final budget and millage
10 rate for the street lighting sub-district in the unincorporated area of Broward County
11 ("Street Lighting Sub-District"); and

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13 WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt a final millage rate for
14 Fiscal Year 2020-2021 for the Street Lighting Sub-District, NOW, THEREFORE,

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16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
17 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

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19 Section 1. The Board hereby adopts a final millage rate of 0.3743 for the Street
20 Lighting Sub-district in the unincorporated area of Broward County for the Fiscal Year
21 beginning October 1, 2020, and ending September 30, 2021, which constitutes a
22 12.00 percent increase in property taxes, as compared to a rolled-back rate of 0.3342.

23 Section 2. This Resolution shall be filed with the Broward County Division of
24 Records, Taxes and Treasury, and a certified copy forwarded to the Broward County

1 Property Appraiser, the Broward County Division of Records, Taxes and Treasury, and
2 the State of Florida Department of Revenue.

3 Section 3. Severability.

4 If any portion of this Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid
5 portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity of the remainder of this
6 Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be
7 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such
8 determination will not affect the applicability of this Resolution to any other individual,
9 group, entity, property, or circumstance.

10 Section 4. Effective Date.

11 This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
