

1 RESOLUTION NO. 2020-600

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 PERTAINING TO WASTEWATER SERVICES; AMENDING  
5 SECTION 38.19 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY  
6 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"), TO  
7 PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF RAW WATER  
8 SUPPLY LARGE USER RATES; AND PROVIDING FOR  
9 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE  
10 CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11 WHEREAS, Broward County provides raw water supply to large users of  
12 Broward County's Regional Raw Water System pursuant to certain Agreements  
13 (the "Agreements");

14 WHEREAS, the Agreements require that Broward County review the rates on an  
15 annual basis, and Broward County has completed its review accordingly;

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-6 of the Broward County Code of  
17 Ordinances, the water and wastewater rates, fees, and charges are required to be  
18 established following public notice and hearing, which, in this matter, have been  
19 satisfied; and

20 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds it is reasonable and in the  
21 best interest of the public to revise Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative  
22 Code to reflect the new rates, fees, and charges for large users of the Regional Raw  
23 Water System effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, 2020, NOW,  
24 THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1 Section 1. The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are  
2 incorporated by reference herein.

3 Section 2. Section 38.19 of the Broward County Administrative Code is hereby  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 **38.19. Raw Water Supply Large User Rates.**

6 The following schedule of rates, fees, and charges for Large Users of the  
7 Regional Raw Water System operated by Broward County Water and Wastewater  
8 Services is effective with all services rendered on or after October 1, ~~2019~~ 2020:

14 Section 3. Severability.

16 to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the  
17 validity of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any Court  
18 determines that this Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be  
19 legally applied to any individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such  
20 determination will not affect the applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to  
21 any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

22 Section 4. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

23 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of  
24 this Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative
