- ► Timely coordination with fire, police, paramedics and other emergency responders on accidents involving elevating devices.







CHAPTER 30

ELEVATORS AND CONVEYING SYSTEMS

SECTION 3001 GENERAL

3001.1 Scope. This chapter governs the design, construction, installation, afteration, repair and maintenance of elevators and conveying systems and their components.

Note: Other administrative and programmatic provisions may apply. See the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR] Chapter 399, Florida Santens; and Rude 616.5, Florida Administrative Code. The regulation and enforcement of the following sections of the adopted codes, and their addenda, are precupated to the and professional regulation: ASME A17.1, ASME A17.3 and ASME A18.

3001.2 Referenced standards. Except as otherwise provided for in this code, the design, construction, installation, alternation, regain and maintenance of elevators and conveying systems and their compositions with a construction of the construction in fload fuzzer and a fact of the construction in fload fuzzer areas established in Section [612.3]. The Division of Housts and Restaurants may great exceptions, variances and waivers to the Elevator Select Code as authorized by the Sulper Code for Elevators and Excultators (ASME A17.1, Section 1.2) and Florida Stantart (Chapter 120.)

 3001.3 Accessibility, Passenger elevators are required to be accessible by the Florida Building Code, Accessibility.

1 3001.4 Change in use. A change in use of an elevator from freight to passenger, passenger to freight, or from one freight as to another freight class shall comply with Section 8.7 of ASME A17.1/CSA B44.

3001.5 Design, installation and alteration of elevators.

3001.5.1 Each new elevator shall comply with the Floride Elevator Safety Code that was in effect at the time of receipt of application for the construction permit for the

3001.5.2 Each alteration to, or relocation of, an elevator shall comply with the Florida Elevator Safety Code that was in effect at the time of receipt of the application for the construction permit for the alteration or relocation.

3001.5.3 All existing elevators shall comply with ASME A17.3

3001.6 As used in this chapter, the term:

ALTERATION. Any change to equipment, including its parts, components, and/or subsystems, other than maintenance, repair, or reolacement.

CERTIFICATE OF OPERATION. A document issued by the department which indicates that the conveyance has had the required safety inspection and tests and that fees

CONVEYANCE. An elevator, dumbwaiter, escalator, moving sidewalk, platform lift and stairway chairful. DEPARTMENT. For the purpose of this section, the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

DIVISION. For the purpose of this section, the Division of Hotels and Restaurants of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

ELEVATOR. One of the following mechanical devices:

- (a) A hoisting and lowering mechanism, equipped with a car and platform that moves in guide rails and serves two or more landings to transport material or passengers or both.
- (b) An escalator, which is a power-driven, inclined continuous stalrway used for raising or lowering passengers.
- (c) A dumbwaiter, which is a hoisting and lowering mechanism equipped with a car of limited size which moves in guide rails and serves two or more landings.
- (d) A moving walk, which is a type of passenger-carrying device on which passengers stand or walk and in which the passenger-carrying surface remains parallel to its direction of motion and is
- (e) An inclined stairway chairlift, which is a device used to transport physically handicapped persons over architectural barriers.
- (f) An inclined or vertical wheelchair lift, which is a device used to transport wheelchair handicapped persons over architectural barriers.

- Man lifts within the scope of ASME A90.1.
- Mobile scaffolds, towers, and platforms within the scope of ANSI A92.
- Powered platforms and equipment for exterior and interior maintenance within the scope of ASME A120.1.

- Cranes, derricks, hoists, hooks, jacks and slings within the scope of ASME B30.
- Industrial trucks within the scope of ASME B56.



Certificate of Operation

- License required by Florida Statute 399 that allows for the operation of elevating devices.
- Certificate of Operation is issued after the device passes an annual safety inspection, or if any violations were cited, they have been corrected within 90 days and all outstanding fees have been paid.
- ► All elevators in Broward County require a Certificate of Operation.
- Operation of an Elevator without a current Certificate of Operation is a violation of Florida Statute 399.






