### Call to Order

Vice-Chair Taylor called the meeting to order at 6:10 pm.

### Roll Call

Ms. Lawson took the attendance. A quorum was met with 5 members present.

### 1. Approval of November 20, 2019 Meeting's Minutes

The CCCAB members approved the minutes.

### 2. County Updates:

- a. **Darby Delsalle of PDMD** shared information on the Wireless Cameras, Wayfinding Signs, Safe Streets, Census 2020, traffic calming petitions, FEMA Flood Zone maps and the panther logo near Dillard High School. There were several questions and a lengthy discussion by CCCAB members on the projects in the BMSD. The members requested a list of projects be prepared and provided to the CCCAB members and, the CCCAB members would like to address Commissioners at an upcoming County Commission meeting.





- b. **Orlando Garcia of Intergovernmental Affairs/Board Section** announced the County is reviewing Sunsetting Boards and he met with staff and the chair of the CCCAB. There are two vacancies in Franklin Park and Washington Park. Residents are encouraged to apply.
  - c. **Ajani Starks of 311/My Broward App** spoke about the app and its tracking once a complaint is reported.
  - d. **Tara Crawford of Transit** informed everyone of Transit’s plans to purchase and install 7 new shelters and initiate micro-transit service. She distributed a map of proposed services in the BMSD.
3. **Broward Sheriff’s Office/BSO Report** Lt. J. Cooper gave the latest in the BMSD, 44 arrests and crime is down 16% from last year. They heard the concerns at the last CCCAB meeting, BSO did an operation and made over 2 dozen arrests.

- a. Roosevelt Gardens area: Ms. Linda Taylor thanked Code Enforcement for citing 2661 NW 15 Court and 2660 NW 15 Court for violations. Mr. Howard Kaplan said the County has done a great job, addressing the nuisance (loud music) at 1190 NW 12 Street.
  - b. Mr. Willie James gave kudos to BSO for focusing in on the prostitution the residents of Washington Park area reported. The activity has been reduced but occurred after someone was killed.
