Call to Order

Chair Brihm called the meeting to order at 6:01 pm.

Roll Call

Ms. Lawson took attendance; 4 members were present and 2 were absent.

1. Approval of February 19, 2020 Meeting's Minutes

2. County Update:

a. Kimm Campbell, Assistant County Administrator

- i. Ms. Campbell introduced herself, explained her role and answered questions about the CARES Act. She encouraged residents to contact

b. Darby Delsalle, Assistant Director of PDMD

- i. Provided updates on the convenience stores, noise ordinance, traffic calming and the 27th Avenue Project.
- ii. Member Rev. Scipio addressed concerns that the 27th Avenue Project started in 2013 and has not been completed. In addition, there were members who mentioned that convenience stores in BMSD are not maintained, need to enforce violations.
- iii. Election of Chair and Vice-Chair: Member Marquis Curry was nominated for Chair by member Linda Taylor and seconded by member Rev. Scipio. Mr. Curry was unanimously elected Chair. Member Marquis Curry nominated Linda Taylor for Vice-Chair and seconded by member Rev. Jesse Scipio. Ms. Taylor was unanimously re-elected Vice-Chair.
- iv. Willowstine Lawson, BMSD Liaison gave a brief overview of the County's federal and state legislative programs. Member Linda Taylor requested a copy be sent to CCCAB members.

3. BSO

- a. Lt. Jeremiah Cooper shared that BSO executed operational plans to combat crimes in Central County. He announced Capt. F. Phillips and Efrain Torres are now a part of the team in District 5. He is working with Mr. Delsalle to address traffic calming devices.
- b. Members inquired about the mortality rate in Central County and BSO's budget for the BMSD.

4. Old Business:

a. Timothy Thomas of the Housing Authority

- i. Mr. Thomas explained his role of compliance and the areas in the BMSD that his office covers. He will provide contact information for the properties they own.

b. Catherine Minnis of the Office of Economic & Small Business Development

- i. Ms. Minnis gave an overview of OESBD's Apprenticeship Program. They will be recruiting BMSD residents who are interested in doing trade work. Due to the pandemic, the recruitment and training have not begun.
