- b. **Gretchen Cassini, Administrator, Mobility Advancement Program** Presented a PowerPoint on the various projects funded by the Penny Sales tax. Gretchen and Tashauna responded to questions from Board members and attendees.
 - c. **Andres Conde, Manager, Solid Waste Collections** Stated Coastal Waste is contractor that picks up garbage, they aren't getting many complaints and they've done unannounced bulk trash pick ups during the pandemic. Residents should call 311 for any requests.
 - d. **Darby Delsalle, Asst. Dir., Urban Planning** Regular meetings with Human Services Dept., BSO and Code to address Homelessness as you are reporting encampments.

Call non-emergency number when possible. Email your elected officials about those they arrest who are released from jail right away. Homelessness- is not a crime to be homeless. Arrest is the last resort. Bus stops we have to address. BSO deals with sensitively and offers help.
