- 2. Dr. Samantha Danchuk provided an overview of staff research on requested items. She mentioned some general tools, and that there were some concepts repeated in throughout many documents: mentioning cost-benefit analysis, resilience standard for buildings, characterize buildings based on their systems, President's Climate Action Plan has many goals related to transparency on energy, need for green infrastructure, and under coordination and policy establishing regionally coordinated effort.
