Position Overview

The Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals (BORA) is seeking a highly qualified and experienced professional to serve as Energy Chief Code Compliance Officer. This senior-level technical and regulatory position is responsible for ensuring uniform enforcement of the Florida Building Code – Energy Conservation Volume and related local amendments throughout Broward County. This position plays a critical leadership role in advancing energy-efficiency standards and maintaining consistent code application across all municipal jurisdictions in Broward County. This position is essential in maintaining the integrity of Broward County’s enhanced code enforcement structure and ensuring consistent application of stringent certification and inspection standards.

Nature of Work

This is advanced technical, regulatory, and oversight work performed under the direction of the Administrative Director.

- Ensures uniform enforcement of the Florida Building Code (FBC) – Energy Conservation Volume and applicable Broward County amendments
- Conducts reviews of municipal building departments to evaluate compliance and proficiency
- Serves as the regulatory liaison between Broward County, municipal building departments, design professionals, licensed contractors, manufacturers, construction industry representatives, law enforcement agencies, stakeholders, and the general public
- Provides technical guidance, interpretation, and dissemination of energy code requirements
- Responds to inquiries and complaints related to energy code enforcement
- Works on appeals, investigations, etc., at the direction of the Administrative Director
- Ensures compliance with BORA certification standards and local qualification requirements

Minimum Qualifications

- Minimum of three (3) years of experience in the enforcement of the Florida Building Code – Energy Conservation Volume

or

- Minimum of three (3) years of experience as a certified energy rater pursuant to Florida Statutes
- Extensive experience in construction and inspection activities related to energy compliance
- Graduation from an accredited community college or formal education in construction-related disciplines, or an equivalent combination of education and experience
- Must be certifiable as a Chief Inspector within the applicable discipline by the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals

Additional Requirements

- Must demonstrate the ability to exercise independent judgment, interpret complex regulatory language, and communicate effectively with public officials, industry professionals, and the general public
