















STAY INFORMED



INTERESTED IN EARNING MORE CONTACT HOURS?

- 28 hours of training are required during the 2-year building certification cycle.
- 60 hours of training are required during the 4-year fire certification cycle.
- By attending Broward BORA's Board and Committee meetings, 1 hour of the required credit will be earned.
- By attending professional association meetings approved by the BORA Staff (i.e. FAPGMI, IAEI, COEA), ½ hour of the required credit will be earned for each meeting attended.

A maximum of 14 total contact hours through Board and Committee meetings can be earned per certification cycle.

2026-2027 BORA RECERTIFICATION CYCLE


The deadline for the **2026-2027 Building Recertification Cycle** is **Thursday, December 4, 2025.** Be sure to submit your recertification packet to the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals office (1 N. University Drive, Suite 3500B, Plantation, FL 33324) prior to the deadline.

Recertification forms can be found on the Broward BORA website. All Building Officials, Assistant Building Officials, Chief Inspectors, Plans Examiners, and Inspectors who are presently certified by BORA must complete this process.

IMPORTANT! Please ensure the following when submitting your recertification:

- Complete and return all forms to the Board of Rules and Appeals office by December 4, 2025.
- Attach the Continuing Education Affidavit signed by the applicant.
- 28 educational contact hours must have been completed by December.
 - NOTE: At least ½ of this requirement must be discipline-specific courses.
- Please include the notarized Affidavit, Board of Rules and Appeals Policy #14-02.
- Your new 2026-2027 recertification cards will be valid through December 31, 2027.

2025 BUILDING SAFETY INSPECTION PROGRAM REMINDER

Earlier this year, municipal building departments throughout Broward County sent notifications to property owners whose buildings are subject to the <u>Building Safety Inspection Program</u>, initiating the process of having the property inspected by a Florida-licensed professional.

Please be advised that the Building Safety Inspection Program does not require the building to be brought up to the current code. If you did not receive a notification and your property is 25 years or older, contact the building department. You will still be held accountable for completing the inspection, whether the municipality contacts you or not.




BROWARD BORA ACH PROGRAM REGISTRATION

Broward BORA accepts Automated Clearing House (ACH) Payments. Payments processed through ACH are not immediate and may take 2-4 business days to complete. To take advantage of the 3% discount, you must submit your payment before the 15th of each month. To request enrollment and report your online payment to BORA, you must send the following documentation to Maria "Pat" Kong:

- 1. Copy of the electronic transaction reporting the total amount made to our account.
- 2. Remittance Advice form with the information about the month reported, showing the deduction of the 3% discount if submitting the electronic payment before the 15th of each month.
- 3. A breakdown showing the minimum \$2.00 charge, if applicable.





BROWARD BORA FIRE EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM


The Board of Rules and Appeals implemented a new program to assist fire departments in hiring new fire inspectors. Individuals who passed the Broward County Fire Inspector Exam will be able to request that their contact information be posted on the Broward BORA website.

If they opt to have their information posted, their name, email address, phone number, and current certifications will be included and available for public viewing. Their contact information will be listed on the BORA website for one year. For additional information, please contact Bryan Parks.

2026 FIRE INSPECTOR EXAM SCHEDULE

The 2026 exam dates are available for the **Broward County Fire Inspector Exam**. To qualify for the exam, submit the completed, signed **application** and policy statement by mail to the Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals or email to **Jonda Joseph**. The Broward County Board of Rules and Appeals will pay for first-time test takers to take the Broward County Fire Inspector Exam. A \$60.00 fee will be required for the test taker to retake the exam.

Broward BORA will, upon request, provide auxiliary aids and services that facilitate effective communication for people with disabilities, including qualified sign language interpreters, assistive listening devices, Braille documents, and other methods of making communication accessible to individuals with speech, hearing, or vision impairments. Please ensure that you request auxiliary aids or services on the application for the exam.


REVISIONS TO THE BROWARD COUNTY UNIFORM BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION

At the **November Board meeting**, the Board approved, by vote, revisions to the **Broward County Uniform Building Permit Application**. The revisions resolve issues related to legislative changes affecting local contractors' licenses and the Notice to Building Officials of the Use of a Private Provider.

The revisions were prompted by Florida House Bill 735, which amended Florida Statute 489 by expressly preempting the state's licensing of occupations and superseding any local government licensing of occupations. The bill specifically prohibits local governments from requiring a license for a person whose job scope does not substantially correspond to that of a contractor or journeyman licensed by the Construction Industry Licensing Board. Specifically, it precludes local governments from requiring a license for the following services: painting, flooring, cabinetry, interior remodeling, handyman services, driveway or tennis court installation, decorative stone, tile, marble, granite, or terrazzo installation, plastering, stuccoing, caulking, canvas awning installation, and ornamental iron installation.

The permit application now includes a checkbox, indicating that the contractor applying for the permit is exempt from licensing by FS 489.117(4)(a)1, and a space to write the contractor's tax receipt number. Additionally, a new checkbox for Private Providers has been introduced, prompting contractors to use the correct **Notice to Building Official of Use of Private Provider**, as adopted by the Florida Building Commission.





UPCOMING BORA CONTINUING EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES


Be sure to start off the 2026-2027 certification cycle strong by participating in **continuing education opportunities**. Twenty-eight educational hours must be completed by the end of the cycle, with at least half of the requirement comprising discipline-specific courses.
