Re: Funding of the Consolidated Regional E911 Communications System

Dear Municipal Managers:

Today, the County Commission rescinded its prior vote to create the Broward Regional Dispatch Program with a city-county cost share through a municipal service taxing unit (MSTU) and other county funding. While acknowledging this is not a County function, the Board again approved creation of the regional dispatch system and approved funding the full operation through multiple county funding sources. We invite each of our municipalities to join the system, whether now or sometime in the future.

As you can imagine, there is a lot to do in a short period of time. A meeting is being scheduled for **9:00 a.m. Thursday May 16th** at the Emergency Operations Center. We will be prepared to discuss our implementation plans and appoint a series of planning and implementation workgroups envisioned to work with the County in developing the Consolidated System.
