Section 27-355(d) of the Broward County Environmental Protection codes states: "Any hazardous material facility, including hazardous material management facilities and hazardous material transfer facilities, which intends to cease operations, initiate a temporary shutdown, transfer its license, or be permanently removed from use or operation, must provide written notification to EPGMD at least thirty (30) days prior to initiating such activities."
