Broward JIC Snapshot #22: Broward Vaccination Rates Rising; New PSA Launched

BY THE NUMBERS – AS OF APRIL 6, 2021

- 620,753 individuals have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine in Broward – 252,447 individuals have received their first dose and 368,306 individuals have completed the series
- According to the latest data from the [U.S. Census Bureau](#), there are approximately 1,952,778 people living in Broward County – 21 percent are under 18 years old, and 17.1 percent are over 65.

VACCINATION AND TESTING SITE UPDATES

There are currently 10 vaccination sites operated by Florida Department of Health in Broward (DOH-Broward) and 9 specimen collection sites operated by DOH-Broward and FDEM.

- The Coral Square Mall walk-up vaccination site will close permanently on Friday, May 14.
- The Mullins Park specimen collection site in Coral Springs will close permanently on Friday, May 14.

There are numerous other state and federal vaccination efforts underway, including mobile "pop-ups" at municipal locations and houses of workshop, at grocery stores and retail pharmacies.
