12-Foot Minimum Height, 2-inch Caliper

Replacement Canopy Area Credit: 300 square feet

Greater than or equal to 13-Foot Height, 2.5-inch Minimum Caliper

Replacement Canopy Area Credit: 350 square feet

Greater than or equal to 16-Foot Height, 3-inch Minimum Caliper

Replacement Canopy Area Credit: 400 square feet
