Luncheon)

CAO: 16-M2 (Gift Reporting and Acceptance)

You are the Legislative Assistant to City Commissioner Yvette Colbourne and you attended an Administrative Professionals Luncheon for City employees presented by the Women in Business Committee of the Miramar Pembroke Pines Chamber of Commerce and hosted by El Dorado Furniture on April 27, 2016. There were a number of drawings for door prizes at this luncheon. You were the winner of a Birthday Package offered by the Hilton Garden Inn. You wish to know whether you will be in compliance with the Broward ethics ordinance should you accept this door prize.

The first question to consider is whether a public officer or employee who wins a prize by chance has received a gift. According to several Florida Commission on Ethics opinions, public officials and employees who attend functions in their official capacity and participate in raffles and other drawings have received gifts if they win one of the prizes given away at these events. Due to the fact you were the winner of the Hilton Garden prize at the luncheon, you will be in receipt of a gift should you redeem it. Consequently, we must analyze whether the local ethics ordinance permits you to keep this gift.

The Broward ethics ordinance applies to all municipal elected officials and their assistants. Section 1-19(c)(1)(a) contains certain restrictions on the acceptance of gifts. Municipal elected officials, their assistants and the relatives of elected officials and assistants are prohibited from accepting gifts valued at more than \$5.00 value from any registered lobbyists or from vendors, contractors, suppliers or potential suppliers of such governmental entity, unless the gift falls under one of the exceptions enumerated in the ordinance. According to the invitation, the luncheon was co-sponsored by a number of organizations, including the City of Miramar, and

none of these organizations meet the definition of a vendor or contractor with the City of Miramar nor are these organizations registered lobbyists with the City. Consequently, you would not be precluded from accepting the hotel stay.

Section 1-9(c)(1)(b) states that elected officials may accept gifts from other sources given to them in their official capacity up to a maximum of \$50 per occurrence. The \$50 limitation is not applicable to gifts to you as a legislative assistance. Therefore, you may accept the Hilton Garden Inn Birthday Package and have no gift reporting obligations under the law.


