Teen Summer Intern Description

DESCRIPTION:

Broward County Libraries (BCL) Teen Leadership Internship Program 2023 will engage students providing a summer-long internship for high school students at participating BCL locations. The internship will introduce teens to emerging technologies, and potential career paths. Participants will gain essential employability and life skills including (time management, communication, leadership, and critical thinking) while increasing their technology skills. Projects will be centered around robotics, music production, film production, coding, 3D printing, arts & crafts, and graphic design.

Northwest Regional Library, Main Library, West Regional Library, South Regional Library, Southwest Regional Library

SCHEDULE:

- Minimum commitment: 120 hours per summer duration, beginning June 2023 and ending in August 2023
- 15-20 hours per week requirement:
 - o Mondays- Students will be required to complete select online components
 - Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday (in-person)
 - o Fridays -Field trips: Additional exploratory learning opportunities will be scheduled on select Fridays

COMPENSATION:

There is a \$650 stipend and other incentives.
