Upcoming Clinic: *April 4th at Roosevelt Gardens Park, 2841 NW 11th Street from 9AM – 2PM.* All dogs must be on a leash and all cats in carriers! Cost is **\$25** for pets that are spayed or neutered, **\$35** for pets that are not spayed or neutered. Price includes rabies vaccination and Broward County rabies registration tag. Microchips will also be available for an additional **\$15**.

Only credit/debit card payments are accepted.

SUNRISE BOULEVARD LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS

The Broward Board of County Commissioners approved the installation and maintenance of landscape improvements along Sunrise Boulevard.

The Sunrise Boulevard Beautification Project is scheduled to begin in June 2015. Landscape and irrigation improvements costing \$192,000 will be installed in the medians on Sunrise Boulevard, between NW 31st Avenue and NW 24th Avenue. Plans incorporate the principles of the Broward County NatureScape Program and Florida-Friendly Landscaping.

FRANKLIN PARK ESTATES PLAT INFILL HOUSING PROJECT

On January 30, 2015, the Housing Finance Authority issued a request for proposals to build an infill housing project, located east of NW 27th Avenue on the south side of Sunrise Boulevard. The proposals are currently under staff review and are tentatively scheduled to be considered by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners on April 14, 2015. The proposed project entails the construction of 18 single-family homes, a sound barrier pre-cast concrete wall, and an entrance sign. Each house will have a minimum of three bedrooms and an enclosed two-car garage, among other amenities.
