



New School Zone Ordinance Promotes Safety

Senator Steve Geller sponsored an Ordinance to install speed detection systems within school zones in the Broward County Municipal Services District (BMSD). Commissioner Robert McKinzie and the rest of the Board supported and approved the Ordinance at the April 22, 2025 Commission meeting. The new speeding system will be installed on the roadways adjacent to Meadowbrook Elementary School and the north side of Dillard High School. The ordinance also provides a framework for municipalities interested in adopting similar measures. Senator Geller hopes that with the enactment of this ordinance there will be a reduction in incidents of injury or death to students as they enter and leave their schools. Speed Mitigation

In response to complaints from residents, Broward County's Traffic Engineering Division has conducted traffic studies at various intersections and neighborhood roadways in the BMSD. Several of the traffic studies demonstrated high-incident areas, based on industry requirements. Residents living along the roadway of those areas were issued a petition for signature. The Traffic Engineering Division will install traffic calming devices in the areas in which the required number of signed petitions were received. Speed hump installation will be scheduled for Roosevelt Gardens, Washington Park and Broadview Park. Coming soon, school signal lights and speed humps will be installed near Dillard High School on NW 27th Avenue and north of Sunrise Blvd.

BMSD Code Compliance

The BMSD Code Inspectors promote compliance with community standards through enforcement of zoning codes, application codes, and other regulations in the Broward County Code of Ordinances within the neighborhoods of the BMSD. Below are a list of standards addressed by the BMSD Code Inspectors:

- Overgrown grass and noxious vegetation
- Improperly stored inoperable or derelict vehicles and vessels (boats)
- Parking or storage of prohibited commercial vehicles in residential neighborhoods
- Unauthorized commercial activities occurring within residential neighborhoods
- Open-air storage of prohibited items
- Discolored building exteriors and graffiti
- Illegal advertising signs
- Landscaping neglect
- Buildings showing visible signs of neglect and disrepair
- Abandoned property
- Improper storage of garbage, recycling carts, and dumpsters
- Construction work without zoning approval and permits
- Minimum housing code standards

Solid Waste & Recycling

Broward County provides garbage collection, bulk waste pick-up and recycling services in the BMSD. To improve your aesthetics, maintain a clean neighborhood. The benefits include healthy breathing, a safer environment, and preserving your property value. It starts with you, prevent littering, illegal dumping and spreading pollution on your block!

- Garbage and recycling carts should be placed out only on the scheduled collection days for your Service Area, leave cart curbside before 7 am but no more than 24 hours prior to collection.

- Carts will not be collected after crews have finished collecting on your street.
- Do not place your carts near mailboxes, fences or cars.
- Property owners are responsible for tenant compliance with all applicable County Codes.
- Carts are the property of Broward County; it is a violation to remove them from assigned addresses.
