PENNY FOR TRANSPORTATION

On the November 6th ballot there is a question about establishing a local option transportation sales tax to fund investments in Broward County's roadways, bridges, school zones, sidewalks, bike paths, community shuttles, on-demand transit service for people with disabling conditions, and general transit system. If approved, the initiative is designed to prioritize projects that will reduce traffic congestion and improve connectivity across the entire county and with neighboring jurisdictions. The collaborative plan includes more than 700 city-requested transportation improvements and almost 500 county projects, including: traffic signal timing, roadway, intersection, and new technology designed to improve the transportation network and options for our residents and millions of visitors, annually.
