Grand Re-Opening Fire Station 23 & Safety Expo

The County, in partnership with the Broward Sheriff's Office, will host a Grand Re-Opening and Ribbon Cutting Ceremony including a Fire Safety & Emergency Preparedness EXPO on Saturday, March 25th from 11AM to 2PM at Fire Station 23, 2200 SW 46th Avenue, in Fort Lauderdale. All residents are welcome to attend. BSO Honor Guard will be in attendance and Meadowbrook students will recite the pledge of allegiance. Event highlights include free food and family entertainment with a bounce house and music, free smoke alarms from Operation S.A.F.E., free emergency and hurricane preparedness kits and resource materials, tour of BSO Fire Engine and County Emergency Command Vehicle, display of art posters by students from Meadowbrook Elementary, and a tour of the newly renovated fire station. The county invested approximately \$300,000 to bring firefighters and medical technicians back to Broadview Park.



It's Spring Cleaning Time



Our annual Community Cleanup is scheduled for Saturday, April 8th. Adults and children of all ages are urged to volunteer. Plan to arrive at Sunview Park at 8:30AM. Broward County Solid Waste and Recycling will provide gloves, safety vests, trash bags, and trash pickers as well as t-shirts and other fun gifts for each participant. Small teams will be assigned to various locations in our community to pick up litter from 9AM to noon. There will be refreshments at the park afterward. This is a great project for scout troops and students in need of community service hours. A large dumpster for bulk trash will be placed on Southwest 18th Street on the south side of the park. Bring tree limbs, yard clippings, paint, insecticide and other hazardous materials. Bulk trash will be picked up throughout the community.
