The Broward County Water and Wastewater Services offers financial assistance to homeowners within the Broward Municipal Services District, including Broadview Park, for connection to its sewer system. Owners of residential property within Broadview Park that are not connected to the sewer system should begin the process as soon as possible. Avoid Potential Code Enforcement Citations!

May 8th is the deadline for owners of private residential property within the Broward Municipal Services District – BMSD (unincorporated Broward County) to submit applications requesting funding assistance to trim, prune, or remove trees that do not comply with FPL's Right Tree – Right Place Guidelines and could cause power outages by damaging or interfering with power lines. All applications **MUST** be postmarked, time stamped by the Planning and Development Management Division, or received by e-mail to AskBMSD@Broward.org by May 8, 2019. Funding assistance is limited and on a first come – first qualified basis.
