Washburn Park Ribbon Cutting Ceremony celebrated the collaborative partnership between Broward County and the Broadview Park neighborhood to transform an unattractive parcel of land into a serene oasis with a butterfly garden and relaxation benches at 1955 SW 50 Avenue. This beautifully manicured pocket park is ideal for health and wellness activities and family recreation. At the request of the Broadview Park Civic Association, the Board of County Commissioners approved the renaming of the pocket park to "Washburn Park" in honor of Jack and Jan Washburn, who co-founded the civic association and were instrumental in continuous community improvement projects, annual food drives and yard sales. According to Dan West, Director of Parks and Recreation, expect more amenities and beautification.
