BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The County Commission is comprised of nine members elected by district in partisan elections. Each Commissioner must be a resident of the district for which he or she seeks election. On the third Tuesday of November, the Commission elects a Mayor and Vice Mayor for one-year terms. The Mayor's functions include serving as presiding officer, and as the County's official representative. The Commission appoints the County Administrator, County Attorney and County Auditor. The Commission also appoints numerous advisory and regulatory boards. There are three Commissioners representing the (BMSD) residential, unincorporated areas.

BMSD Code Compliance: Compliance with community standards is promoted through the enforcement of zoning codes, application codes and other regulations in the Broward County Code of Ordinances within the neighborhoods of the Broward Municipal Services District (BMSD). BMSD Zoning: Broward County Zoning administers the **Zoning Code, Chapter 39**, of the Broward County Code of Ordinances, as it applies only to the **BMSD**, which are the unincorporated areas of Broward County.

Historic Preservation Program: The Broward County Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance #2014-32 that created a new Historic Preservation Board (HPB) and established criteria for designating historic and archaeological resources, which are applicable in unincorporated Broward County and in municipalities that have not established local historical preservation ordinances.

The HPB designates or recommends for designation of historic landmarks and districts, and then reviews

applications to alter, add on, demolish or move a landmark or property within a historic district. Comprehensive plans, zoning, subdivision and other land use laws can also be instrumental in supporting historic preservation and neighborhood conservation programs.

Tenants and Landlords: Just as tenants have responsibilities under Florida law and through lease agreements including paying rent, keeping the unit clean and in working order and not disturbing the peace, landlords have certain requirements and restrictions as well, such as providing a clean and safe property by maintaining the major systems and the building structure. Landlords in Broward County are also required to provide notice to tenants informing them when a late fee has been incurred. **Broward County Landlord/Tenant FAQs**

CONSUMER PROTECTION BOARD

Promote, protect, and improve the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Broward County, by hearing consumer complaints submitted against businesses where unfair, deceptive, or illegal activity is alleged. Created pursuant to Broward County Charter, Article I, <u>Article I, Section 1.04 (o)</u>.

ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING

The Tree Preservation Program enforces Chapter 27, Article XIV of the Broward County Pollution Control Code, titled "Tree Preservation and Abuse Ordinance."

Tree Preservation Program Areas of Responsibility and Municipalities

The Tree Preservation and Abuse Ordinance has Countywide authority, although it is not enforced in municipalities that have as stringent regulations. Currently the Tree Preservation Program covers specific <u>Municipalities and Unincorporated Broward County</u>.


