

'NAM DOC MAI' MANGO

Mango spp.



- **Height: 10-15 feet**
- **Flavor: Sweet, tropical**
- **Texture: Smooth, no fiber**
- **Ripens June to July**
- **Full sun**

'PICKERING' MANGO

Mango spp.



- **Height: Condo-dwarf compact. 10+ Feet**
- **Flavor: Mild-classic, coconut**
- **Texture: Smooth, min. fiber**
- **Ripens June-July**
- **Full Sun**

'HONEY KISS' MANGO

Mango spp.



- **Dwarf, compact to 10 Feet**
- **Flavor: Classic, sweet honey**
- **Texture: Smooth, no fiber**
- **Ripens: July-August**
- **Full Sun**

BARBADOS CHERRY

Malpighia glabra



- **Shrub-like tree 10-15 Ft.**
- **High drought tolerance, likes part shade/part sun**
- **Tart but sweet fruit, extremely high in vitamin C**
- **Produces Year Round**

STAR FRUIT

Averrhoa carambola



- **12 up to 20 ft tall x 12 wide**
- **Pink flowers, not wind tolerant or drought tolerant**
- **Sweet to slightly tart fruit. Ripe apple, pear, and citrus undertones**
- **Full Sun**

ARABICA COFFEE

Coffea Arabica



- **Size: Small, 4-6 ft.**
- **Likes well-drained, acidic soil and shade**
- **Exquisite flavor, sweet, nutty undertones**

LOQUAT

Eriobotrya japonica



- **Size: Small-medium, 25 ft max.**
- **Sweet yellow fruit**
- **Prefers a sunny, well-drained spot. Drought tolerant**

LONGAN

Dimocarpus longan Lour.



- **Size: Medium-large, 20-40 ft**
- **Bears fruit erratically- not every year!**
- **Sweet, floral tasting fruit with a single seed in the center.**
- **Full Sun**

FLORIDA BOXWOOD

Schaefferia frutescens



- **Slow growing**
- **Prefers light shade**
- **Long lived**
- **Evergreen. Flowers and fruits all year.**
- **Height: Small, 8-15 ft**

JOEWOOD

Jacquinia keyensis



- **Very slow growing**
- **Fragrant flowers, birds eat fruit**
- **Height: small, 4-10 ft.**
- **Full sun**

CINNECORD

Vachellia choriophylla



- **Moderate to fast growth rate**
- **Showy yellow flowers**
- **High drought tolerance**
- **Thornless variety**
- **Height: small, 8-12 ft.**
- **Full Sun**

SIMPSON'S STOPPER

Myrcianthes fragrans



- **Aromatic leaves**
- **Nectar-source for butterflies, attracts mockingbirds**
- **Sun or shade**
- **Height: medium, 5-20 ft.**

BLACK IRONWOOD

Krugiodendron ferreum



- **Very slow growing**
- **Hurricane resistant**
- **Birds eat fruit**
- **Height: medium, 25-35 ft.**
- **Full Sun**

ORANGE GEIGER

Cordia sebestena



- **Bright orange flowers**
- **Coarse texture**
- **High tolerance to salt spray**
- **Height: Medium, 25-30 ft.**
- **Full Sun**

FIDDLEWOOD

Citharexylum spinosum



- **Slow to moderate growth rate**
- **Fragrant flowers nectar Source**
- **Orange fruit eaten by wildlife**
- **Height: Medium, 12-25 ft.**
- **Full Sun**

BAHAMA STRONGBARK

Bouffreria succulenta



- Weeping habit
- Attracts mockingbirds, hummingbirds, & butterflies
- Height: 15-20 ft.
- Full Sun to Part Shade

GUMBO LIMBO

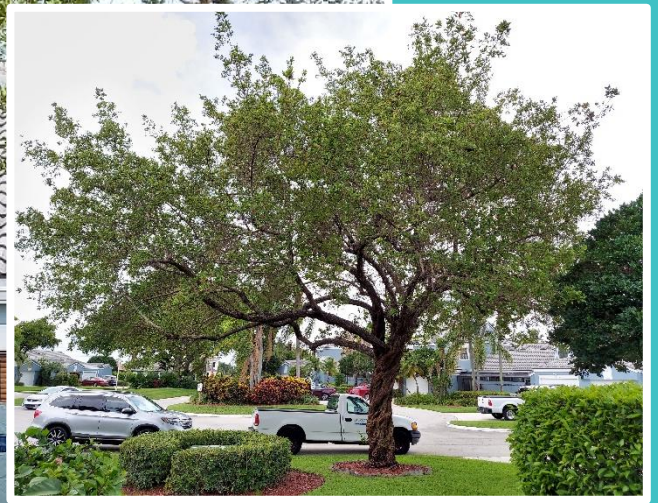
Bursera simaruba



- **Flaking/peeling bark**
- **Crows & parrots attracted to fruit.**
Warblers attracted to insects on tree
- **High tolerance to salt spray & drought**
- **Height: 20-30 ft.**
- **Full Sun**

GREEN BUTTONWOOD

Conocarpus erectus



- **Interesting bark at maturity**
- **Tolerant of a wide range of conditions, high tolerance to salt spray**
- **Height: 20-40 ft.**

FLORIDA THATCH PALM

Thrinax radiata



- **Slow growing endangered Palm**
- **Hurricane wind resistant**
- **Nesting site & food source for birds**
- **Height 15-30 ft.**
- **Popular pool planter Palm**

COONTIE

Zamia pumila



- **Small shrub 1-4 Ft. slow growing**
- **Larval host for the rare Atala butterfly**
- **Dry to moist soil**
- **Full sun to deep shade**
- **Seeds poisonous to dogs**

SWEET ALMOND

Aloysia virgata



- **Fragrant, almond-scented flowers**
- **Nectar source for pollinators**
- **Woody shrub, 4 Ft. up to 15 Ft.**
- **Full sun to partial shade**
