



Acknowledgment of COVID-19 Guidelines for Registered Vendors

Broward County Parks and Recreation Division (“County”) is happy to welcome you back into our parks for our rentals, but we have some new requirements and expectations at this time to keep you, park patrons, and our staff safe.

The undersigned representative acknowledges and understands that Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) was declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization and that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) has stated that “the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.” Additional information on the CDC guidelines related to COVID-19 may be found at: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>.

Some of the important points for you and your representatives to consider are:

- Facial coverings/masks must always be worn by all persons, except when actively eating or drinking.
- Rental capacity is limited to a maximum of 50 percent, not to exceed 100 persons, although some facilities are lower. Please double-check the rental agreement for the maximum attendance. Registered Vendor representatives must be factored into the reduced capacity limit of the rental facility.
- Representatives that are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have been potentially exposed to someone with COVID-19 symptoms must remain home and not join events hosted at parks. Temperatures must be checked prior to arrival at the park, if they exceed 100.4 F, they shall not enter the park.
- Guests shall not serve themselves from “buffet-style” lines. There should be a dedicated person, wearing mask and gloves, responsible for serving guests food and desserts.
- It is your responsibility to read and follow all applicable Emergency Orders, even if not directly referenced here.

Upon receipt of this signed form, your vendor application will be extended by eight months to compensate for the period of time that the County was closed for facility rentals (March 17 to November 12, 2020). If your certificate of insurance is expired, a current copy must be submitted as well.
